

Taking care of your product

Your furniture should require no more than a regular dust off with a soft cloth. If the furniture is not painted then a superior wood polish can be used - but never use polishes containing silicone.

If necessary it can be cleaned with a damp cloth with a mild detergent solution - and then dried with a lint-free cloth. Never clean with abrasives or chemical cleaners. Direct sunlight or heat from a radiator can stain, discolour warp or crack furniture. We know furniture can be heavy but try not to drag furniture across the floor as this can damage it.

PRODUCT SAFETY

The recommended size of the mattress is 191cm x 120cm (6'3" x 4'0)

Periodically check all fittings to ensure that none have come loose.

Keep away from direct sources of heat, such as electric, gas or coal fires.

Do not allow children to Climb on the furniture.

Using this furniture other than for its intended purpose could cause damage to the structure or serious injury to your child.

The Bed should not be used if any structural part is broken or missing.


If you can manage it, please try to persuade your children not to bounce on the bed.



4 x nuts, 4 x washers, 4 x spring washers & 4 x threaded bars



8 x Dowels 30 x Screws



Screwdriver Spanner


Fitting the bed legs.


4 threaded bars and 8 wooden dowels

Insert and rotate each threaded bar into the centre hole on each bed leg. Now insert the wooden dowels into the two holes either side.



Making the bed. (Two people required)
Slide each mattress rail onto the threaded bar and wooden dowels that you have fitted in the legs.
Carefully slide the lunar washer onto the threaded bar as it passes through the large hole in each mattress rail. As this bar passes through the lunar washer slip on the spring washer then the normal washer and then finally the nut. Push the bed frame together. Rotate the nut using the spanner provided and tighten the bed frame.






Fix the base

30 x Wood screws Lift the slatted base onto the bed, slide out and screw down.

Note: Both bed end slats should be tightly fitted at each end.


The Bed should not be used if any structural part is broken or missing.






Fit the Castors

4 x castor pins and 4 x castors.

Push the castor pins into the castor bush (located on the bottom of the front and back panels (shown on the images)).


Then push each castor onto the pins. Some light force may be needed to make them "click" together.



Fit the Brackets

 $16 \times Fat screws and 4 \times bed brackets$

Screw the Brackets to the bed ends as shown.




Make the bed


8 x short bolts

Insert the short bolts into the 8 metal fittings in both the front panel and rear panel, rotating them in about halfway. Orientate the the parts so that the front is opposite the rear and with an end panel at each side.

Start at one corner, slip one end part over the two short bolts fitted in the front panel, once over the heads, let the bracket drop down onto the shaft and tighten both bolts onto the bracket. Repeat the same process on the remaining corners.

Note; the end panels are orientated so that the bracket is nearer to the top edge of the part.






Completed Bed Frame with ALL four corners made.

Fixing the base

12 x Wood screws

Drop the 3 x base boards into the bed and arrange so that the gaps between these parts are roughly equal. Now simply screw down each board until secure.



Fit 2 x rubber buffers to the inside of the trundle front, this will help protect the paintwork of your products. (Closing the trundle onto the bed mattress rail)

Lay the mattress within the trundle and on the top of the base, or use the product as a storage unit.

Push the trundle under the upper bed being aware of the gaps around the bed.
