

Mayfair Bed Frame ( 135 cm & 150 cm )





WARNING!!! The two USB fitted to this bed are for charging your phone only.





## **Safety Advice**

Please read these instructions carefully before you begin, when finished store safely for future reference.

It would be sensible to lay down a sheet or blanket on the floor in the room you are going to assemble the product in, this will help to avoid scratching the product and will help to protect the floor.

If the product is going to be used on a wood, laminate or tiled floor, we would recommend the use of anti-slip pads, these are available cheaply in most good hardware stores.

Unpack the product carefully, inspect all parts and check all the parts are in the box remembering some parts are in the back of the headboard, check all hardware and make sure all numbers match the AI.

We strongly recommend that children are kept out of the area where the bed is being assembled as there are several small parts that could present a choking hazard.

Do not use any power tools in the assemble of this bed at ANY time.

When you start to assemble the product, we recommend you put all small parts i.e. nut, bolts etc. into a bowel, this way you're less likely to lose any parts. Do not fully tighten bolts till your product is fully assembled. Do not tighten the bolts fully until the bed has been completely built.

# **Safety Warning**

The design and construction of the base is made to only work with a mattress on top, do not sleep on the base without a mattress.


Every 3 months re-tighten the bolts to make sure they have not worked loose.

Make sure all 4 feet are in contact with the floor, if not use the adjustment on the feet to make it happen.

If for any reason you want to move the product to a different location the bed MUST be fully dismantled first to prevent damage.

The USB's fitted to this bed are for 2A or less appliances, such as phone or ipad charging only, use only 1 appliance per side at any one time.

Multi appliance cables must never be used, if used the kill switch will stop the switch functioning and a new switch will need to be fitted.







Please double check before reporting short.







All wires, including TV power cable,


video and audio cables go through

Tip: When fitting the TV, ensure that the top of the TV is lower than the small wheels on the TV lift frame and that the bottom of the TV clears the top of the footboard, so as not to obscure the TV display.







Four M4 x 15mm bolts are provided, as they fit more commonly available TVs. In the event that they do not fit, please check to see if some were provided with your TV, otherwise you will need to purchase the correct bolts for your specific TV make and model yourself. Any local DIY store should be able to provide you with these.







## **General Care**

Vacuum the fabric area on a regular basis to take out any surface dust or grit.

Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasives.

Never drag or push the pieces across the floor as this will cause damage to the joints and could result in failure to the product that will invalidate the warranty.

Never rub hard on the fabric to get a stain out. If you can't remove it with a clean damp white cloth, seek for professional advice.

Always lift the product when moving, making sure the main plugs has been removed and be aware of damaging the cables.

Please take care of the use of the USB. Sockets are for PHONE CHARING ONLY.

Do not place any objects on top of the footboard, as this may affect the performance of the TV lift and cause damage.

When not in use, it is recommended to turn off all power to the bed.

NEVER sleep on the slats without a mattress fitted, they are made to work together.

# **Notes**

When you go away for long periods, ie holidays etc. it's always good practice to pull plugs out of electrical equipment.

We've tried to make this piece of furniture as easy to assemble as possible.

In the unlikely event that you have poblems putting it together or have damaged or missing pieces, please contact your supplier.
